

Getting from Manchester and Manchester Airport to Ulverston by train

How long will it take?

Approximately 2 hours

Where can I find the train times?

Do I need to change trains?

There are some direct trains, and some that change at Preston or Lancaster

How much is a ticket?

A standard single ticket from Manchester Piccadilly costs £28.80. A return costs £32

A standard single ticket from Manchester Airport costs £32.40. A return costs £40.30

The train companies often offer cheap single tickets, if you search in advance you may find a single ticket as cheap as £8. So it may be possible to get a return journey for as little as £16. If you buy these types of tickets you will have to be on the specified train.

Anything else I need to know?

There may be some work taking place on the train lines on **Saturday or Sunday** during the festival. Details have not been released yet and will be posted here as soon as they become available.

We recommend that you purchase and pick up your ticket in advance if you plan to travel from Ulverston on Sunday or bank holiday Monday, as the ticket office is closed.

If you plan to pick up your ticket from the machines at the station, make sure that you bring the credit card that you used for booking with you, along with your booking reference number.
